Solutions & Dilutions

To Neutralize Odors ... Anywhere ... Everywhere ... On Anything ... And Then Some

Airborne

Spray GONE freely in the air starting as high as possible.

Bedding and Pillows

Spray freely over bedding and pillows. (*Delicate fabrics spot test first*)

Bird Cages Remove bird from cage, clean and spray cage pan let dry before placing bird in cage. (*Do not spray on or where birds are present.*)

Carpets/Rugs/Upholstery/Vehicles Clean the thoroughly and get as dry as possible then spray GONE full strength directly on spot let air dry. (*Delicate fabrics spot test first*) If its urine and it soaked into the fabric or ran down inside the furniture. Mix 1 part GONE with 2 parts water, use a squirt bottle with a pointed tip applicator, squirt the spot so the GONE can follow the path of the pee and neutralize the smell. **Clothing** Spray freely on smelly clothing, let dry before wearing. (*Delicate fabrics spot test first*)

Fuel Spill

Mix a diluted solution of 1-part GONE to 2 parts water and pour or somehow let it run the same path of oil spill...The GONE needs to touch the source for success. Spray freely throughout building for airborne odors.

Furniture or Mattress Clean the thoroughly and get as dry as possible then spray GONE full strength directly on spot let air dry. (*Delicate fabrics spot test first*) If its urine and it soaked into the fabric or ran down inside the furniture. Mix 1 part GONE with 2 parts water, use a squirt bottle with a pointed tip applicator, squirt the spot so the GONE can follow the path of the pee and neutralize the smell.

Hard Floors/Walls Clean up - spray and wipe - then spray and let dry... For large areas mix (1 part GONE & 2 parts water) use a rag mop or garden sprayer and soak thoroughly, let dry. For daily mop out spray treat the hot spots and add couple of ounces to the mop bucket when you mop the whole floor. Walls, woodwork, cabinet's mix 1 part GONE with one part water and wash down, let dry.

Hotel / Motel

Spray GONE around the room, the furniture, curtains and in the heating and air conditioning unit in the room.

HVAC If you have central air or forced hot air heat the HVAC system is a source for the odor and a good way to treat the whole building...Remove filter. With system running, spray full strength directly into air intake until you detect GONE at the furthest register or vent in the building. This will neutralize any foul odor in the system ducts and help disperse the GONE throughout the building. Repeat as necessary until odor is GONE.

Kennels - Cages -Dog Runs - Back Yard

Spray freely when cleaning cages. Use garden hose end sprayer attachment that will automatically mix GONE with the water and thoroughly soak down the area. (*Do not get in pet's eyes*)

Laundry

Add 2oz GONE to wash or rinse cycle. For stubborn odors, add 2 oz. to both wash and rinse. (*Rinse cycle tip. Use the fabric softener dispenser.*) **Soak**, add 4 oz. GONE per ½ gallon of water in bucket, soak clothing for 15 minutes, pour entire contents of GONE and clothing into machine add detergent and wash in soak cycle. Add 2oz GONE to rinse cycle.

Litter Pan

Spray freely over litter. Spray and let dry after cleaning. (*Do not spray kittens.*)

Steamer's /Extractors/ Shampoo Machines

Add 4oz. GONE per ½ gallon of cleaning solution... Pre-treat hot spots by spraying GONE full strength on every spot.

Vehicles

Spray GONE throughout entire vehicle, trunk or cargo area. (*Do not soak headliner*) Spray GONE into H.V.A.C. system at air intake with system running on low. Spray GONE and wipe all washable surfaces.





SKUNKED Plus... Anything Rover can roll in!!!

Surprise!... Got Skunked?... Pee On the Carpet? Or Worse ... Now What?... Skunk spray, and anything Rover rolls in is no problem for GONE ... When your pet is skunked, it is not fun, it always happens when you least expect. Keep in mind not only does your pet get it so do you and anything they touch; collar, clothing, carpets, couch, car, etc.... If you had this happen, you know exactly what I mean. The best thing you can do is hold your nose and pull out the GONE!

Everyday Doggy...wet dog or in-between baths etc.

Just wet a washcloth and give your pet a good rubdown until fur is damp.

Skunked Pet

Things you will need:

GONE Odor Neutralizer

Small Bucket: To soak collar, lead etc.

Squirt Bottle with a Pointed Tip Applicator: Most dogs do not like the sprayer and may become nervous. The pointed tip you can direct the GONE exactly where you need it without waste and will not frighten your pet.

Wash Cloth: To use on face, snout and ears and will help avoid getting any in your pet's eyes. Clean Towels: 2 or 3 Pet Shampoo/Conditioner: To finish the job like a PRO

Getting Started

Spray GONE full strength to knock down the airborne skunk odor and improve working conditions.

Remove collar and place in small bucket. Mix 1 part GONE to 1 part water, soak until Odor is GONE.

With your pointed tip applicator squirt GONE full strength directly on skunked areas and work in thoroughly. Use washcloth for face, snout and ears. *(Avoid getting into eyes... it is like soap in your eye.)*

With your pointed tip applicator squirt GONE full strength and thoroughly work into the rest of your pet's coat working from the top down. GONE does not take long to do its job so by the time you are finished working it in you can rinse your pet thoroughly. *(In extreme cases rinse and repeat)*

Lightly towel dry from head to tail checking for any spot you may have missed double-checking the hot spots or areas that took the direct hit. Re-apply GONE to missed spots and rub in. *(Be careful and take your time, if you miss a spot the size of a dime you will still smell skunk)*

Use your favorite pet shampoo/conditioner and dry with a clean fresh towel.

KISS YOUR PET ON THE HEAD AND GIVE FAVORITE TREAT!!!

If you get a whiff a few days later, or find a spot you may have missed, just wet a washcloth with GONE or squirt a little from your pointed tip applicator or spray from the bottle and rub out the odor.
